
TAKE BEFO

BEFORE YOU OPERATE A NON CONVENTIONAL VEHICLE (NCV) ON CAMPUS, YOU MUST COMPLETE THE ONLINE TRAINING LOCATED AT aub.ie/carttraining



INSPECT YOUR VEHICLE BEFORE EACH USE. CHECK THE TIRES, BRAKES, AND LIGHTS. MAKE SURE THE VEHICLE IS IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION BEFORE OPERATING.



ALL PASSENGERS SHOULD BE INSIDE THE VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT HANG EXTREMETIES OVER THE EDGE OR RIDE ON EXTERIOR. IF CARRYING ITEMS, MAKE SURE CARGO IS PROPERLY SECURED.



WHEN OPERATING: USE SAFE PATHS FREE FROM DEBRIS, OBSTACLES, AND HAZARDS. AVOID DISTRACTING DRIVING AND OBEY ALL TRAFFIC LAWS AND REGULATIONS.
